

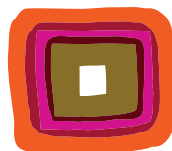


Online training with the Centre for Culture, Ethnicity and Health

Introduction to Cultural Competence

Suitable for health professionals who work with people from migrant and refugee backgrounds.

This introductory course provides a framework for health sector workers.

Designed for the health sector it helps participants define concepts of culture and cultural competence, its importance and identifies the impact of cultural interpretations and bias in your work. It also gives clear guidance on how to develop strategies to improve your cultural competence.

The course had four modules which take ten minutes to complete at your own pace or in one session of forty minutes.



Working across Language and Culture

Suitable for all client facing staff who work with people from migrant from refugee backgrounds.

This course gives your staff the key skills and knowledge to work with people from different cultures or from different language groups. It is practical and uses engaging multimedia activities to reinforce learning. It also includes links to many valuable resources.

Participants gain practical strategies and knowledge of how to approach cross-cultural interactions and use interpreters effectively. The course sets a clear agenda for creating a culturally responsive workplace that can navigate and excel in cultural diversity.

This course has eight 10-12 minute modules which can be completed at your own pace or in one session of ninety minutes.



Health Literacy Essentials (in development)

Suitable for all staff that need to work effectively with the different communication needs of clients.

This training lets your staff practice using health literacy concepts and skills in realistic workplace scenarios. Staff gain key knowledge about how you can make your workplace easier to access and use for the widest possible range of consumers.

Participants completing this course gain a clear understanding of health literacy principles and models of practice. They are introduced to ideas of plain language across written and spoken communication. They learn how to apply health literacy tools and strategies relevant to their role and responsibilities. Tips on how to implement health literacy initiatives that are culturally responsive and consumer focussed are also included.

This course has six modules that can be completed in an hour.
